



Concertmaster Job Description

The Concertmaster reports to the Music Director. The Concertmaster can be scheduled for up to 8 (eight) services per week during the KSO's 35-week season.

Concertmaster will:

- Perform all subscription concerts (Masterworks, Chamber, Pops, Family), opera and ballet productions, run-out concerts, and other full and/or chamber orchestra services.
 - Concertmaster may request to be excused from certain services at the beginning of each season if such request is made in writing and only with the approval of the Music Director and Executive Director.
- Provide bowings for works to be rehearsed and performed in a timely fashion as requested by KSO librarian;
- Participate in KSO auditions as requested;
- Participate in meetings and/or artistic leadership activities as requested;
- Participate in fundraising and/or public relations appearances as requested during the season for the purpose of promoting the KSO;
- Perform at fundraising and/or public relations events during the season for the KSO or Knoxville Symphony League for the purpose of promoting the KSO (i.e. Lucas Richman Society dinner, League luncheon, etc.);
- Regular meetings with the Music Director to discuss string section bowings and other matters pertaining to the Knoxville Symphony Orchestra;
- Abide by all terms and covenants of the current Master Agreement between KSO and Local 546, and the bylaws and policies established by the KSO;
