SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION

The new Online Grant application will become available at 8:00am CT on August 13, 2019.

Below is a list of information that schools will need in order to complete the application.

Applicants are ***strongly encouraged*** to prepare this information ahead of time so that when the application becomes available, it can be completed in a short amount of time. **Please use the checklist below as a worksheet to gather information before the application opens.**

Step 2: Complete your Organization Profile
